# 2023 SCHOOL CONTRIBUTIONS AND CHARGES

The Education Act 1999 requires schools to notify parents of all contributions and charges prior to the start of the school year. These costs are divided into three areas: Voluntary Contributions, Student Requirement List and Extra Cost Options. The Mandurah Primary School Board has endorsed the schedule of Contributions and Charges for 2023.

# • VOLUNTARY CONTRIBUTIONS

A voluntary contribution towards the cost of items used in the educational program provided for your child.

### • EXTRA COST ITEMS

An estimate of the costs of these items is listed for non-compulsory activities. Payment for these items is a condition for participation by students.

# STUDENT REQUIREMENT LIST

Items on this list are required for students use in their classroom.

1. Mandurah Primary School Board have endorsed an amount of \$25 per KINDY student and \$50 per PP to Year 6 student as the Voluntary Contribution for 2023. These contributions are voluntary. They enhance the teaching and learning opportunities for all students and supplement funding gained from other sources, including the State and Federal governments. At Mandurah Primary School, the **Voluntary Contributions** will be used to purchase supplementary materials and resources used in classrooms in the following areas:

- Literacy and Numeracy Resources
- History, Geography and Science Resources
- Visual Arts Materials
- Class cooking activities
- > Information Communication Technology (ICT) Resources
- Library Books

### 2. Student Requirement List

The cost for items on this list will vary between year levels. It includes such items as pens, pencils and scrapbooks. Parents may purchase these items from their chosen retailer or use the nominated school supplier **West School Supplies.** The school receives a small commission for each order processed through this company.

You can also pay your **Voluntary Contributions** of either **\$25 for Kindy** or **\$50 for all other students** for 2023 through **West School Supplies** when you order your child's Student Requirements.

#### 3. Extra Cost Items
